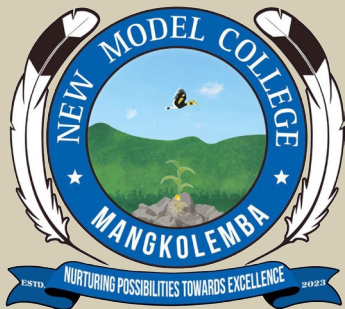

# COURSES OFFERED & Admission Procedure

Under the Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP), the college offers only Major courses (No General) in the following six subjects - Economics, Education, English, History, Political Science and Sociology and Minor Courses in Economics, Education, History, Political Science and Sociology.

**The Admission procedure for candidates applying for the courses are as follows:**

- Candidates with a minimum of 45% of marks in HSSLC exam will be eligible to apply.
- The intake capacity for each department is 25 seats.
- Documents to be submitted during admission
  - i. One copy of HSLC Admit Card and Marksheet
  - ii. One copy of HSSLC Admit Card & Marksheet
  - iii. Four (4) Passport Size Photos
  - iv. Aadhaar No., Gmail Id & Phone No.
  - v. Migration Certificate for students coming from Board / University other than NBSE / NU
  - vi. ST/ SC / OBC / PwD Certificate if applicable
  - vii. Character certificate from the institution last attended
  - viii. Pledge form duly signed
